#### STAFF ACTIVITIES

Payments and service calls continue to keep the office and field staff incredibly busy. The second round of bills were mailed out at the end of May, and the second payment is due at the end of June.

The BVID rental house was listed for sale on May 17, 2024 and the perimeter fence was completed on May 14, 2024. Since being listed, the house has been shown twice.

The Technical Services Manager continues to work on Sicard Pipeline easements through the UC and the permits for the Porter Creek crossing. BVID legal has submitted their comments on the easement agreement and staff will re-submit to legal next week.

The Manager signed the services agreement for the BVID office design on June 3, 2024 and the design is currently being worked on by the engineer.

Don Moss has been working with Canyon Hydro on finalizing the proposal for the Virginia Ranch Dam generator and staff submitted the additional requested items to DOE on June 6, 2024.

The ice machine has quit, and staff is looking into options to replace it. The repair technician pointed to one of the main issues being the hard water and abundance of calcium and minerals in the water.

As of today, there have been several applications submitted for the Utility Worker position and one has applied for temporary summer work.

### **CURRENT PROJECTS**

#### Sicard Flat Pipeline

The crew has been cleaning up the properties along the pipeline and backfilling. Fusion is expected to resume when the easement with the UC is complete.

#### **Upper District**

Operations staff continue to be busy with repairs throughout the District. Mainline breaks on the Sandy Way Pipeline and multiple breaks on the Able Pipeline have been repaired. Staff have also been preparing Virginia Ranch Dam for the upcoming FERC inspection.

Backfill, cleanup, and fence repair continues on the Sicard Pipeline Project.

Crew is currently mechanically cleaning the Thousand Trails Ditch and the Harding Canal upstream of Township Road.

Spraying and mowing of vegetation is being conducted as weather permits.

# **Lower District**

Pumpline Canal is running at 60 cfs.

Mechanical cleaning of the Canal is underway and will continue, as necessary.
