STAFF ACTIVITIES

Final payments continue to trickle in as the final payment for the 2024 irrigation season was due August 31, 2024.

On September 17, 2024, the Yuba Water Agency Board of Directors unanimously voted to approve the Supplemental EIR to extend the Lower Yuba River Accord's Water Transfer program for another 25 years, through 2050.

The Technical Services Manager received the go-ahead from the UC on the Sicard Pipeline easements through the UC property, however, the District has not received an update on when the UC will be able

to sign the easement agree. The Technical Services Manager continues to work with the UC management on getting the document signed.

The Manager received the Program Agreement document for the Hydro Efficiency grant. It has been reviewed by the Manager, the Technical Services Manager and the MBK Project Manager. The document has been signed and returned to the Department of Energy for signature.

The Manager and Director Bordsen met with the Operating Engineers 3 (OE3) representative and the OE3 representative agreed with the proposed changes to the MOU.

CURRENT PROJECTS

Sicard Flat Pipeline

Fusion is expected to resume when the easement with the UC is complete. Per the easement agreement, the UC is requesting a 10-day notice prior to work. Fusion is anticipated to resume in October.

BVID Property

The approved floor plan was sent to the Engineer on September 10, 2024.
